## **Internship Description:**

Internship will offer hands-on experience in public relations, fundraising campaigns, social media management, strategic planning and media placement.

Interns will assist with projects such as:

- Promotional emails (monthly content calendar, copywriting)
- Quarterly newsletters
- Website updates (creation of pages, copywriting, image searches, etc.)
- Public Relations efforts, including:
  - Collaboration with 3<sup>rd</sup> party PR representative in the creation of pitch calendars, releases, and coordination of guest speakers/interviews
  - On-site coordination of guests and press
- Direct Appeal Campaigns (Winter & Spring Fundraising Campaigns)
  - Campaign strategy, content creation and coordination with advertising agency of record
- Social Media
  - Content calendar for foundation Facebook & Twitter pages
  - Coordination with other foundation departments in creation of weekly content
  - Timely replies to followers with questions on either platform
  - On-site social media coverage at foundation special events
- Strategic planning behind general promotion of: donations, special events, patient services, donor awareness project, vehicle donation program and mission.

Start Date: Position open until filled, requires 3-6 month commitment

Hours: 12-15 hours per week

**Compensation:** This unpaid/volunteer internship can fulfill school credit requirements. Internships may or may not be eligible for college credit, based on the various college/university guidelines; it is the intern's responsibility to make sure the internship meets these guidelines.
